

# 3rd Grade Summer Reading 2017-2018

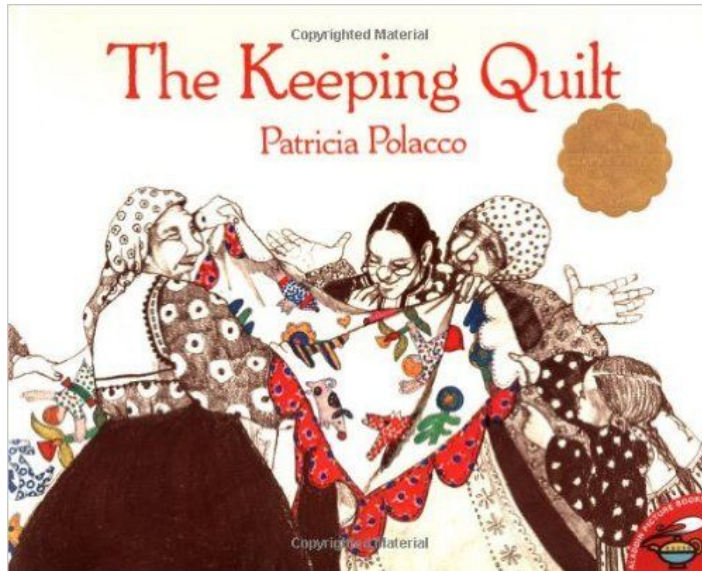
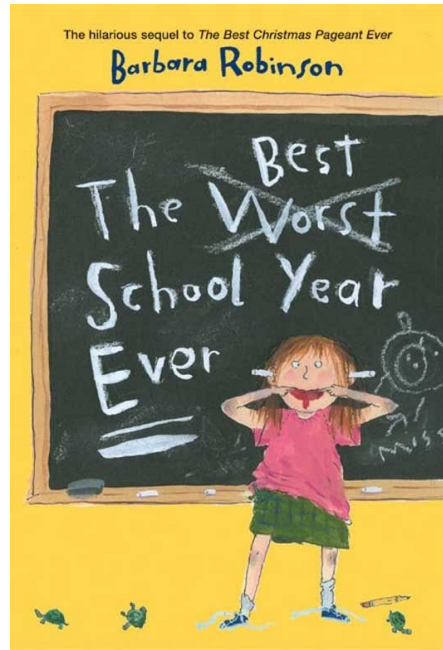
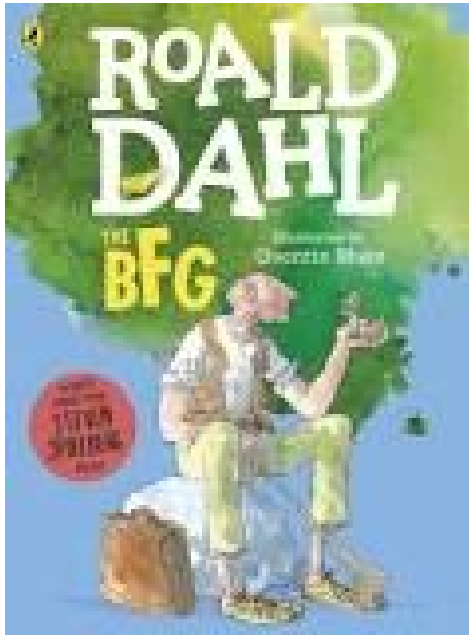
Why encourage a summer reading plan for your children?

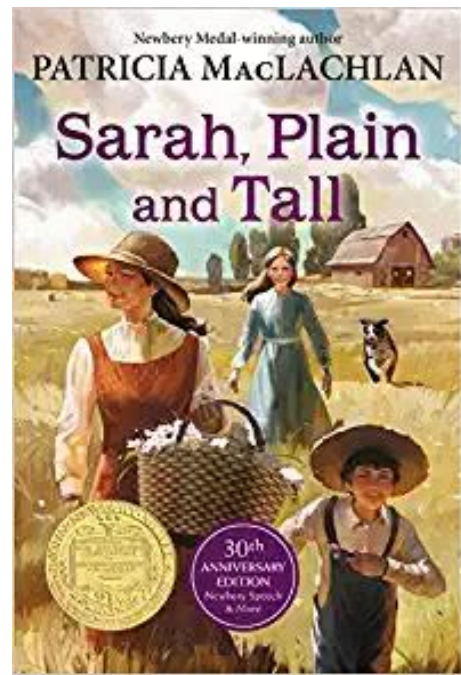
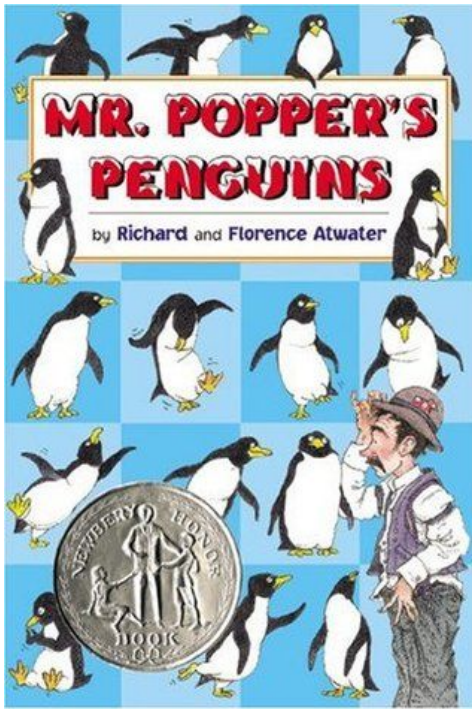
Research shows that children can lose up to three months of learned materials without a summer reading program. It also suggests that children who read as few as six books over the summer maintain the level of reading skills they achieved during the preceding school year. Reading more books leads to greater success.

Knoxville Christian School is requiring a summer reading program to enter into the third grade. At this grade level students are required to read three (3) books. The assignment is to be completed and returned to the teacher by the first (1st) day of the second (2nd) quarter. These assignments will be part of the reading grade for the third quarter.

In order to prepare for the third grade at Knoxville Christian School, students should read three (3) of the following books over the summer. They will then fill out a book report form (attached) for each book.
